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Apprentice Technician (3 Openings)

Qualifications

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Experienced Technician (7 Openings)

We are seeking experienced, journey-level low-voltage technicians to independently perform installation, termination, testing, troubleshooting, and closeout work for structured cabling, fiber optics, audiovisual, networking, and other low-voltage systems. This role serves as the on-site lead for assigned projects, directing daily field operations, coordinating with contractors, mentoring apprentices, and ensuring quality workmanship from installation through project closeout.

Key Responsibilities

- Install, terminate, test, label, and troubleshoot structured cabling, fiber, AV, network, and other low-voltage systems.
- Read and interpret construction drawings, schematics, and project plans.
- Lead assigned crews and serve as the primary field contact for the general contractor and project stakeholders.
- Assign daily tasks, monitor progress, and verify completed work.
- Mentor apprentices and less-experienced technicians through hands-on training and quality oversight.
- Ensure work is completed safely and in compliance with project specifications, industry standards, and company expectations.
- Complete testing, documentation, punch-list resolution, and final work-order closeout.
- Submit progress photos and end-of-day notes through the company CRM.

Required Qualifications

- 3+ years of low-voltage or structured cabling field experience (equivalent competency may be considered).
- Ability to read construction drawings and schematics.
- OSHA 10-Hour Construction certification (OSHA 30 preferred for lead technicians).
- Scissor Lift and Boom Lift Operator certifications.
- Demonstrated fiber optic termination and testing competency.
- Fall Protection training/certification.
- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation.
- Ability to pass a background check and drug screening.



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
